Please observe the following:

On the Course

- A Rake bunkers after use
- B Repair pitch marks
- C Do **not** wheel trolleys over tees and greens
- D It is prohibited by law to consume alcohol anywhere on the course

In the Clubhouse

- A Jackets must be worn in the dining room
- B To purchase/consume alcohol - 18 years and over

Local Rules

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)
 a) Beyond any wall, fence, or line of white stakes defining the boundary of the course.
 b) On the beach.
 c) Paved area immediately surrounding the Clubhouse, unless otherwise indicated.

2. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE
 Stone walls, stone buildings, timber sheds, shelters and "man-made" paths: the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable.

3. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)
 Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)
 a) Hose points.
 b) Distance disks.
 c) Benches and their hard standings.
 d) Fixed sprinkler heads
 NOTE: All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction, on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played, intervenes on the line of play between the ball

and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows: if the ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard, and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention, c) is not a hazard or on a putting green.

5. TEEING GROUNDS
 Except in Club competitions, a ball played on to the teeing ground other than that from which a player is playing **must** be lifted and dropped clear of the tee but not nearer the hole, without penalty.

6. RETRIEVAL OF GOLF BALLS
 It is forbidden to enter any garden of any property surrounding the course to retrieve golf balls.

7. SLOW PLAY
 If a game fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it **must** invite the match following to pass.

8. GENERAL
 It is strictly forbidden to practice from the tees, bunkers, on or onto the greens.
